DEVELOP RUBRIC

Each quality review cycle begins with the development of a rubric that is connected to MS CCRS and defines quality for each content area. Rubrics are posted on the [MIMM website](#) for publisher and district use.

REVIEW QUALITY

All submitted materials are reviewed for content, instructional concepts, and educator supports. Reviewers spend an allotted amount of time evaluating materials and uploading scores and comments to digital review portal.



RECRUIT TEACHER REVIEW TEAMS

Review teams and standards-alignment teams include educators from around the state. Every member is rigorously vetted and trained to ensure that evaluations are detailed and comprehensive.

PUBLISH REVIEWS

Final reports are published on the [Mississippi Instructional Materials Matter website](#). Districts can use the [Adoption Samples Site](#) to vet adopted materials prior to purchase.
