Project Schedule and Implementation Plan

Timeline

- **Get Ready:** *Spring 2025*
The objectives of the first phase are to identify your state and districts' specific needs and desired outcomes, gather feedback, discuss standards alignment, determine district leadership teams, and schedule initial training.
- **Get Set:** *Summer 2025*
The objectives of this preparatory phase are to set goals for the first year of implementation, develop custom resources as needed, and host training sessions for leadership and educators. Training may occur in person, live virtually, asynchronously, and/or via a train-the-trainer model.
- **Go:** *2025-2026 School Year*
Implementation begins! Educators utilize QuaverMusic with ongoing feedback and support, such as regular data reporting, continued product training, and professional learning opportunities.
- **Reflect:** *Spring 2026*
At the end of the first year of implementation, we will analyze data and feedback gathered. We will consider areas for improvement and celebrate successes!
